D'ici le 1er avril 2018: soumission des dossiers

Eligibility criteria

Must have a Master degree at the time of their enrolment: *1-9-2018 (or 1-10-2018)*

MSCA mobility standards: show transnational mobility by having not resided or carried out their main activity in France for more than 12 months in the 3 years before the call deadline. *Between 1st of April 2015 and 1st of April 2018*

Early Stage Researchers conditions: in the first four years of their research careers and not have a doctoral degree. *Master degree after the 1st of April 2014*

Should speak French or English (no check)

D'ici le 1er avril 2018: soumission des dossiers

Main ethical issues

Funding will not be granted for activities:

- carried out outside the EU if they are prohibited in all Member States
- that destroy human embryos (for example, for obtaining stem cells)

The research project must have an exclusive focus on civil applications.

Mobilité / Co-direction

A research visit abroad of at least two months will be mandatory. However, the cumulative duration of professional trips abroad should not exceed 12 months during the 36 months of the MathInParis PhD contract, which includes a maximum period of 9 months in the country of origin of the PhD fellow.





- Projet scientifique détaillé
- Lettre de recommandation des DU et directeurs des ED
- « Ethical issues questionnaire »
- Faire attention au dépôt de justificatif pour les conditions d'éligibilité !

Début des 20 thèses : 1er Septembre 2018 ou 1er Octobre 2018.

Les obligations des “MathInParis fellows”

Reporting

- Within 20 days of the start of fellowship
 - A declaration with personal and fellowship information
 - Fill in the mobility form

Mid-term:

- Fill a questionnaire giving details on expected non-academic skills to gain and ethics issues
- A presentation to a Thesis Committee according to the rules of each Doctoral School

Yearly report to MathInParis Board

H2020 rules

Ensure **open access** to all peer reviewed scientific publications relating to its results.

Obligation to comply **research integrity principles** and fulfil the **ethical procedure**
